All cadets attending NJROTC classes at Lassiter will be expected to adhere to the rules and regulations as stated in their respective Student Handbook and also strictly follow the below listed additional requirements:

- 1. I will not use alcohol products of any kind.
- 2. I will not use tobacco products of any kind, including e-cigarettes or vaping products of any kind.
- 3. I will not use drugs of any kind including prescription medications without a doctor's authorization.
- 4. I will adhere to the "zero tolerance" requirement regarding weapons.
- 5. I understand that females will be allowed only in female rooms and males allowed only in male rooms on any field trip.
- 6. I understand that muster times for NJROTC events will be strictly adhered to.
- 7. I will observe all curfews during field trips or other events as required.
- 8. I will not use profanity.
- 9. I will not tolerate theft of any kind.
- 10. I will accept and abide by other school/unit/Navy requirements as required.
 - This includes but is not limited to: (a) No wearing of earrings by male cadets in the

(a) No wearing of earrings by male cadets in the NJROTC classroom or anytime while wearing the Navy Uniform. "Just got them pierced and can't take them out because they will close up." is not an acceptable excuse. NO EXCEPTIONS!

(b) Any visible body piercings, other than earrings, to include tongue studs and navel piercings.

- (c) Wearing of the Navy uniform that brings discredit to the unit.
- 11. I will respect and not question the SNSI/NSI/Teacher's directions.
- 12. I will be especially respectful to all adults, display good manners, and help out and volunteer every chance I get.

Any violation in this contract will result in restriction from further activities during NJROTC events and will result in a letter being sent to parents placing their child into a "Probationary Status." The letter will describe the situation and the consequences to follow if the situation in question continues. Cadets continuing their inappropriate behavior while in a "Probationary Status" will be disenrolled from the NJROTC program, they will receive a grade of 10 for the semester and will be placed into a study class.

I have read, understand and will comply with all of the above requirements, and thoroughly understand that any infractions will result in disciplinary action or disenrollment.
